STANDARDISED PRICELIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this price list for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	£2835
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£1450
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (within a 30 miles radius of our premises) into our care	£200
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased will be kept at Tom Ross and Sons, Orchard Road, Forres, IV36 1PJ or at a branch of your choosing	£250
Providing a suitable coffin – This will be made from an oak veneer	£639
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director *By law a fee is listed but we do not charge for viewings	£1*
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (within 30 miles of our premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£295
UNATTENDED FUNERAL This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

TERMS OF BUSINESS
